This petition is came up on 03.01.2025 for final hearing before me in the presence of M/s. Rahul Jaganathan, R. Lokeshwaran, Deepak, Learned Counsels for the 1st petitioner and of M/s. S. Ramanathan, R. Dinesh Kumar, R. Keerthana, Revathi Ashokan, Learned Counsel for the 2nd petitioner and upon hearing the arguments and perusing records and having stood over for consideration till this day, this court delivered the following:-

<u>ORDER</u>

This Petition was filed under section 13 (B) of Hindu Marriages Act, praying to pass a decree declaring the marriage solemnized between the petitioners on 11.11.2021 at Arasan Palace, No.7, Moovarasampet Main Road, Madipakkam, Chennai – 600 091 under the Hindu rites and customs be dissolved by mutual consent and for such other reliefs.

2) Since it was an application filed under section 13 (B) of Hindu Marriages Act' 1955, both the petitioners were present at the time of presentation

of this petition. On that day of first hearing, this court heard the contentions of both the petitioners and advised them to think over the issue by trying to find a possibility of reunion and to reconsider the decision of getting a divorce. Considering the age of the petitioners this Court granted six months cooling period to the petitioners as per section 13 (B) (2) of Hindu Marriage Act.

- 3) The petitioners appeared on 03.01.2025 On that day, on enquiry both the petitioners reported that there is no possibility of reunion and they don't require any further time for reconsideration. Accordingly petitioners were examined as PW1, PW2 and Exhibits Ex.P1 to P5 were marked.
- 4) On hearing both the petitioners and their counsel, this Court found that the couples were not blessed any child and now they have been living separately since 03.04.2022 and even after negotiation by the family elders, they were not able to resolve their disputes and live together. Before this Court also, both the petitioners jointly stated that there is no chance for them to live together, and also agreed to follow the recitals as averred in the petition relating to all facts. Therefore, considering the submissions of the petitioners and the fact that they were not able to settle their disputes, live together and that they stood firm on their decision to get divorce, this court holds that there is no scope for reunion and so, is inclined to grant divorce. Accordingly, the petition is allowed.
- 5) In the result, this petition is allowed by granting a decree for divorce, by dissolving the marriage solemnized between the petitioners on 11.11.2021 at Arasan Palace, No.7, Moovarasampet Main Road, Madipakkam, Chennai 600 091
